TO: ALL MEMBER COMPANIES WITH INTERESTS IN WEST BENGAL

Commencement of Plucking / Manufacturing Operations in Season 2025 - West Bengal

This is further to the Association's Circular No. 26/204-25 dated 16th July 2024 informing members about the directive of Tea Board mandating the cut-off dates for closure of manufacturing operations in the Season 2024.

Members are hereby informed that Tea Board has now issued an Order viz. Order No. 12(17)/LC/2008/P-III/768 dated 29th January, 2025 with regard to **commencement of plucking /manufacturing operations in Season 2025**.

Details of the Order are as follows:

Tea Board has stated that manufacturers adopting pruning / other cultivation practices other than traditional method as well as manufacturers of Orthodox, Green and Specialty teas may seek exemption from the respective office of Tea Board.



ORDER

- Whereas in exercise of powers conferred under clause 13(3) of the Tea (Marketing) Control Order, 2003, an Order Ref. No.12(17)/LC/2008/Part-III/502 dated 15th July, 2024 was issued by the Licensing & Registering Authority of Tea Board, inter alia, in respect of the last date of plucking/receiving of green tea leaves and its last date of processing by the tea manufacturing units in the region of North Bengal including Sikkim & Darjeeling Hills for the season ending November, 2024 for mandatory compliance by all the tea manufacturing unit.
- Whereas, plucking of tea leaf and manufacturing of tea will have to be commenced from the next cropping season in the year 2025 after the winter dormancy of the tea bushes is over and the tea bushes start producing tea leaf/sprouting buds afresh.
- Whereas, suggestions/feedbacks have been heard/received from the Industry stakeholder, scientific Institution for stipulating a suitable timeline of starting of the current cropping season's tea manufacturing in accordance with the natural cropping pattern of the tea bushes.
- Therefore, in continuation to the Order referred above in Sl. No.1, the following directives are hereby issued for mandatory compliance by all the tea manufacturers and producers of the Dooars, Terai, Bihar, Sikkim & Darjeeling Hills, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand regions:

- Gardens which have adopted pruning / other cultivation practices other than traditional method and except early crop / as well as manufacturers of orthodox, green and specialty teas, may seek exemption from respective office of the Board.
- Officers not below the rank of Assistant Director of Tea Development are authorized to recommend such exemption sought for, if any, to their Zonal/Regional Offices (Siliguri & Palampur) for issuance after due field verification. Exemption granted (if any) is to be intimated to the Head Office of the Board. While issuing such exemptions, the Officers shall take into account pruning practices, irrigation facilities, early rains which might lead to early flushing and flushing pattern.
